A community-based residential program for adults with developmental disabilities.

This program provides personal, social and behavioral skills training to improve an individual's quality of daily life. The program's primary focus is to facilitate independent living and self-empowerment, while operating in accordance with Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services (DBHDS) Human Rights and Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Rights regulations. Each individual has a private bedroom.

Services include:

- Person-centered planning
- Skill assessment
- Resident supervision and support
- Community participation
- Social interaction

- Assistance with medical appointments
- Training to develop abilities in personal selfcare and how to access community resources
- Training to develop social and emotional awareness and positive behaviors
