Colonial Behavioral Health (CBH) is seeking individuals currently receiving services and/or their family members to join our Advisory Council. Roles and Responsibilities

General Members shall:

- Attend Advisory Council meetings and any other Board committee meetings as assigned by the Chairperson.
- Take an interest in state, regional and local community service board issues.
- Review program performance reports and provide input into quality improvement plans.
- Serve as an advocate for the Agency.
- Represent the Agency at community events.



Recruitment and Selection Process

Interested individuals should speak with staff for a brief application.

CBH's Executive Committee will review the applications and make recommendations to the Board of Directors for appointments to begin in January 2025. The Advisory Council will consist of five members, serving a term of two years. Meetings will occur at least quarterly.
