## Duties and Responsibilities

## Terms of Service

Terms of service are for three years. Board members are eligible to serve three full, three-year terms on the Board.

## Board Committees

- **Executive Committee**  
Sets Board agenda, acts in between Board meetings as needed to transact business, participates in Board Development
- **Administrative Committee**  
Establishes the budget, reviews agency audit, reviews Board Financial Management policies, reviews policies
- **Service and Evaluation**  
Reviews agency services, established Board need for service-related reports, reviews program outcomes
- **Public Awareness Committee**  
Engages in public awareness and legislative issues
- **Strategic Planning**  
Oversees and coordinates Board strategic planning activities, holds regular quarterly meetings, membership consists of the chairs from the other Board Committees
