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- Case Management: linkage to mental health resources, family supports, and community-based services
- Outpatient Services: short-term individual and family therapy
- Psychiatric Services: medication management - must be coupled with another service
- Short-Term Crisis Counseling: stabilization of an acute mental health crisis episode
- Substance Use Services: treating mild misuse
